

CALVARY PRAYER GUIDE

For Week of Prayer and Fasting: May 26 - June 1, 2025

*Calvary's Session is calling for a **Week of Prayer and Fasting** as we ask the Lord to work in and through **Vacation Bible School** in mid-June to reach children in our community with the gospel.*

Our goal is that at least two people will pray and fast each day of the week.

To assist you with your day of prayer and fasting, we have provided a guide you can use to lead you throughout the day with particular emphasis on our part in God's mission to reach the generations through His church.

Each season, below, could correspond with a particular hour of the day, so that we might seek His face throughout the day. For example, you could start with Season 1 at 8 AM, followed by Season 2 at 9 AM and so on. If you miss an hour (i.e. 10 AM), you would just pick up with the next Season (3) the next hour (11 AM).

- **Season #1 - Pray for God to be glorified in this generation and the next through VBS.**

Ephesians 3:20-21 - ²⁰ Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, ²¹ to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

- **Season #2 - Pray that we would invite our neighbors and friends, particularly children, in this community to magnify the God who made us and redeemed us in Christ.**

Psalm 34:3, 11

³ Oh, magnify the Lord with me,
and let us exalt his name together!...

¹¹ Come, O children, listen to me;
I will teach you the fear of the Lord.

- **Season #3 - Pray the Lord would remove all barriers to children hearing about and experiencing the love of God in Christ through VBS.**

Mark 10:13-16 - ¹³ And they were bringing children to him that he might touch them, and the disciples rebuked them. ¹⁴ But when Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them, "Let the children come to me; do not hinder them, for to such belongs the kingdom of God. ¹⁵ Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the kingdom of God like a child shall not enter it." ¹⁶ And he took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands on them.

- **Season #4 - Pray the Lord would draw children from the neighborhoods on Ray Road to VBS, including *Autumn Chase, Laurel Oaks, Madison Glen, Winthrop Drive, and Hampton Oaks*, and pray for a great gospel harvest.**

Matthew 9:35-38 - ³⁵ And Jesus went throughout all the cities and villages, teaching in their synagogues and proclaiming the gospel of the kingdom and healing every disease and every affliction. ³⁶ When he saw the crowds, he had compassion for them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd. ³⁷ Then he said to his disciples, "The harvest is plentiful, but the laborers are few; ³⁸ therefore pray earnestly to the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers into his harvest."

CALVARY PRAYER GUIDE

For Week of Prayer and Fasting: May 26 - June 1, 2025

- **Season #5 - Pray for unity for the VBS team, as they prepare to show and share the love of Christ with this community and particularly the rising generation.**

John 17:20-23 - ²⁰“I do not ask for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word, ²¹that they may all be one, just as you, Father, are in me, and I in you, that they also may be in us, so that the world may believe that you have sent me. ²²The glory that you have given me I have given to them, that they may be one even as we are one, ²³I in them and you in me, that they may become perfectly one, so that the world may know that you sent me and loved them even as you loved me.

- **Season #6 - Pray for those who will be teaching during VBS to faithfully proclaim the Gospel of God’s mighty acts through Christ.**

Psalms 145:4 - ⁴One generation shall commend your works to another, and shall declare your mighty acts.

Deuteronomy 6:4-9. ⁴“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God, the Lord is one. ⁵You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. ⁶And these words that I command you today shall be on your heart. ⁷You shall teach them diligently to your children, and shall talk of them when you sit in your house, and when you walk by the way, and when you lie down, and when you rise. ⁸You shall bind them as a sign on your hand, and they shall be as frontlets between your eyes. ⁹You shall write them on the doorposts of your house and on your gates.

- **Season #7 - Pray that the children who participate at VBS will hear the Lord through His gospel and embrace Christ through faith.**

Isaiah 54:13-14 - ¹³All your children shall be taught by the Lord, and great shall be the peace of your children. ¹⁴In righteousness you shall be established; you shall be far from oppression, for you shall not fear; and from terror, for it shall not come near you.

- **Season #8 - Pray that we would experience the joy of children coming to faith in Jesus and be strengthened in their walk with Jesus.**

3 John 1:4- ⁴I have no greater joy than to hear that my children are walking in the truth.
