All: Christ teaches us this summary in Matthew 22: "You shall love the Lord Your God with all your heart, and with all your soul, and with all your mind, and with all your strength. This is the first and great commandment; and the second is like it: You shall love your neighbor as yourself. On these two commandments depend all the law and the prophets."

All: No, for I am by nature inclined to hate God and my neighbor.

CONFESSION OF SIN

From Worship Sourcebook, J.2.2 #19

Leader: Lamb of God, we are burdened: we do not love You as we should.

All: We forget our dependence on You and do not honor You. Instead of glorifying You, we try to bring ourselves glory.

Leader: Lamb of God, we are burdened: we do not love others as we should.

All: We hurry through our days and miss opportunities to be Your hands and feet. We judge quickly and respond

thoughtlessly.

Leader: Lamb of God, we are burdened: we do not love ourselves as we should.

All: We disparage our appearances, criticize our best efforts, and misuse our bodies.

Leader: Lamb of God, we are burdened: we are weighed down by the bad things that are done to us.

All: We hold grudges, harbor bad feelings, and believe lies told about us.

Leader: Lamb of God, we are burdened: we are overwhelmed by sin.

All: Man of Sorrows, You know our pain and suffering. By Your wounds we are healed.

Leader: As we now silently confess our sins of omission and commission to You, Lamb of God, take our burdens, we pray, and free us from sin.
